## Notice of Race

### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, RRS 2009-2012.

### 2. Entry

2.1 Any boat and/or owner that meets the eligibility requirements in this Notice of Race may enter. Eligible boats may be entered by paying the entry fee, completing a Long Beach Yacht Club race entry form and filing it with the Race Committee prior to 1000 hours Friday, July 24, 2009.

2.2 An entry fee of \$ 125.00 is payable no later than at the time of registration. Make check payable to Cal 25, Fleet V.

### 3. Eligibility Requirements

3.1 The Skipper must be a legitimate owner of a Cal 25. Short-term ownership (less than one month) may not be allowed.

3.2 The Organizing Committee reserves the right to evaluate and make a ruling on the eligibility of interested competitors that do not meet requirements 3.1.

3.3 The Organizing Committee shall be the entity authorized to make rulings in matters pertaining to interpretation of Fleet V and Cal 25 rules and measurements.

3.4 All boats shall conform to the newly adopted Cal25 National rules ([www.cal25.com](http://www.cal25.com)). For this regatta, yachts shall be allowed to use one non conforming #2 head sail previously approved by the fleet (grandfathered into the fleet prior to 2008). All other sails shall conform to the new National rules.

#### **4. Yacht Inspection**

All yachts and sails must be inspected and certified before a competitor will be allowed to compete in this regatta. This activity will be conducted under the direction and control of the Fleet Lieutenant who is deemed to be the official measurer of Fleet V. Yacht Inspection and Sail Measurement **will not** be conducted on Friday, July 24, unless the Fleet Lieutenant has granted prior approval.

#### **5. Schedule of Events**

##### **Thursday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>**

- 1800 hours, Final inspection of yachts and sail measurement. (Competitors are encouraged to make an appointment with the Fleet Lieutenant prior to this date).
- No Host Bar, Hors d'oeuvres at Long Beach Yacht Club

##### **Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>**

- 0900 hours. Skipper's Meeting at Long Beach Yacht Club.
- 1200 hours: Racing Begins
- 1800 hours: No Host, Hors d'oeuvres at Long Beach Yacht Club

##### **Saturday, July 25<sup>th</sup>**

- 1200 hours: Racing Begins
- 1800 hours: No Host Cocktail reception and Buffet Dinner at Long Beach Yacht Club

##### **Sunday, July 26<sup>th</sup>**

- 1200 hours. Racing Begins
- 1600 hours. Trophy presentation will follow racing and disposition of protests

#### **6. Advertising**

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

#### **8. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions will be available after 1800 hours on July 21, 2009, at the Long Beach Yacht Club

## **9. Racing Courses**

The racing area will be located 3/4ths of a mile westerly of the Alamitos Bay Jetty. Windward/Leeward courses, with distances varying from 1.6 to 6.1 nautical miles will be utilized.

## **10. Scoring**

Ten races are scheduled. Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than ten races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When ten races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This Regatta will be scored in accordance with RRS 90.3.

## **11. Trophies**

Trophies will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place finishers. Additional trophies, if warranted, may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
